Dear Parent / Carers,

In Year 6, we have been very busy preparing for the fast-approaching SATs tests. We will be contacting you soon to discuss your child's progress and their individual arrangements for SATs week. However, please find some general information about the Key Stage 2 SATs below.

The Key Stage 2 tests are timetabled from **Monday 9th May to Thursday 12th May 2022**. The order of tests are as follows:

Monday 9th May 2022 – English Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar (45 Minute Punctuation and Grammar, then separate Spelling paper)

Tuesday 10th May 2022 – Reading (1 Hour)

Wednesday 11th May 2022 – Maths Paper 1 (Arithmetic – 30 Minutes) and 2 (Reasoning/Problem Solving – 40 Minutes)

Thursday 12th May 2022 – Maths Paper 3 (Reasoning/Problem Solving – 40 Minutes)

During SATs week, we will be holding a Year 6 Breakfast Club. This is free, and all children are encouraged to attend. It will begin at 8am, and will be held in the Main Hall, so children should enter school via Reception. SATs Breakfast Club is a tradition at Brinsworth Howarth, and it gives children a calm start to the day, and time to discuss and ready themselves for the tests that morning.

All of the tests are held in the morning, with most of them starting at approximately 9am. These tests are statutory, and therefore attendance is compulsory. In the unlikely event that your child is extremely unwell during this week, then you should follow the usual sickness reporting procedure. Results will be released to school on Tuesday 5th July 2022.

After SATs week, our learning does not stop. Our focus will turn to Writing, which is prepared, edited and assessed throughout May and June. Please avoid taking your child out of school during these months.
