## School Uniform Policy

Following consultation with parents in June 2009, it was decided that parents liked the school uniform as it gave the children a sense of pride in belonging to our school and is hard wearing and practical for the demands of a busy day. School sweatshirts, cardigans and fleeces can be purchased at very reasonable prices from school – please pick up an order form from the Office. Other items can be purchased inexpensively from supermarkets and other shops.

Wearing a uniform is very helpful to parents because it takes away the morning problem of ‘what shall I wear today?’ It also reduces pressure on parents to buy expensive clothes so children can compete with others.

All our pupils are expected to dress in school uniform. A full list of uniform is listed below.

Boys: Black, grey or navy trousers

White plain polo shirts

School sweatshirt

Socks white, navy blue, black, grey.

In the summer black, grey or navy shorts may be worn.

Girls: Black, grey or navy trousers

Or black, grey or navy skirt

Or pinafore dress

White plain polo shirts

School sweatshirt or school cardigan

In the summer black, grey or navy shorts or green and white summer dresses may be worn.

Tights/socks white, Navy blue, grey, black

Footwear should be dark coloured shoes, boots or trainers and in the summer a full sandal.

The following items are optional: school full zip polar fleece jacket in bottle green.

Please make sure that all clothing is clearly marked with your child's name so lost items can be returned.

Children are not allowed to wear:

Shoes with a heel, crocs, flip flop style shoe or mules.

No jewellery apart from small studs for pierced ears only (no coloured earrings)

No jeans/ tracksuit bottoms/leggings under skirts/dresses

No brightly coloured socks or tights.

No nail varnish

No fake tattoos.

P.E. Kit

For both indoor and outdoor P.E. children must have a full change of clothes including footwear. This is to encourage a healthy, hygienic approach to physical activity.

Indoor P.E. Kit:

Plain dark blue/black shorts – no logos please

Plain white T shirt

Children will do indoor P.E in bare feet.

Outdoor P.E Kit

Plain dark blue/black shorts – no logos please

Plain white T shirt

In colder weather a tracksuit or sweatshirt could be worn

Pumps or trainers (separate to what the children wear to school)

Earrings must be removed for all P.E. activities including swimming. If ears have recently been pierced, studs may be covered with a plaster (supplied by home). This is in line with the P.E. guidelines of the Local Authority.
