Things you can do to help your child:

- Read to and read with your child daily
- Make sure they have their full PE kit on the correct day.
- Ask your child what they have been learning
- Give them opportunities to visit the library or websites to 'read around' the topic and gather information of interest to them.

Homework:

- Homework will be sent out with various activities on for you to choose from.
- Please make sure you complete all activities with your child by the end of each half term and they can be brought into school as and when children complete them.
- We ask that your child has the opportunity to read as regularly as possible. It has been proven that reading up to 5 minutes a day has a huge impact on progress.
- Children should read a minimum of 3 times per week at home and should bring their books into school to be changed on Mondays and Thursdays.
