**ANCIENT GREECE**



Our topic this term is Ancient Greece and we will be reading the novel "Who let the Gods out?" by Maz Evans. As well as a trip to Robin Hood's Bay, we are planning to hold a "Greek Day" in school after half term - details to follow.

Literacy

In Literacy we will be studying our class novel, writing diary entries as Athenians and Spartans, and learning how to write argument texts. Myths and Legends will also be covered and we will be re-writing some classics and inventing our own.

Numeracy

The children will extend and consolidate their knowledge of fractions, decimals and percentages, as well as covering coordinates, properties of shape and statistics. Problem solving activities and investigations will continue to form part of our maths work. As always, a strong emphasis will be placed on mental calculation strategies and knowing our tables

Science: In science we will be finding out about the properties of light and how it travels. We will also be looking at forces including water and resistance and friction.

DT: We will be examining how to make recipes healthier.

Art: We will be working towards our entry for the 'Picture This' competition

RE: We will be studying the unit "What Bible Stories tell us?"

MFL: We will be following the Oakwood French scheme.

This term we will continue to think about forming positive relationships in The Caring School, Bullying, pressures and risks and e-safety - chatting safely online. We will also be looking at the changes that happen to our bodies during puberty - a further letter about this will be sent.
